CT of Orbital Multiple Myeloma

An article by Price et al. [1] refers to the only previously reported case of CT in orbital multiple myeloma to their knowledge, which was published in 1977.

While we made no priority claims, it appears that our article, "Orbital Involvement by Plasmacytoma; Report of Two Cases" [2], was in fact the first to report CT findings in multiple myeloma (plasmacytoma). Our published CT images were admittedly crude, but they showed findings similar to the recent *AJNR* article.
