For the radiologist, there is valuable information in most of the book—for example, in functional endoscopic and image-guided surgery of the paranasal sinuses; in surgical approaches to base of skull masses; in surgery for neck and thyroid masses; and in the whole realm of temporal bone lesions, hearing restoration, and CSF leaks. It is always good for the radiologist to know, at least to a moderate extent, how the ear, nose, and throat surgeons approach those abnormalities that we identify at imaging. This short tome fills the bill.
