

**ON-LINE FIG 1.** Schematic drawings of the 4 patterns of subependymal enhancement. *A*, Type I: enhancement at the ependymal lining abutting the newly developed or enlarged measurable contrast-enhancing lesion. *B*, Type II: enhancement extending along the ventricular margin with the distance of extension (ie, distance from the margin of the enhancing lesion to the farthest end of the subependymal enhancement) measuring ≤1 cm. *C*, Type III: enhancement extending along the ventricular margin with the distance of extension measuring >1 cm. *D*, Type IV: enhancement at the ependymal lining isolated from the enhancing lesion.
